

CONSTITUTION VANDERBILT VOLLEYBALL CLUB

PURPOSE: The purpose of this organization shall be:

- 1) to promote volleyball through competition in United States Volleyball Association (USVBA) tournaments & NIRSA tournaments
- 2) to provide competition in volleyball on a more highly structured level than intramurals
- 3) to promote volleyball by conducting several tournaments at Vanderbilt

ORGANIZATION:

- 1) There shall be at least one organizational meeting each year in an attempt to contact new volleyball players in the University community
- 2) Management of the club:
 - a. There shall be two officers of the club, a coach and an assistant coach
 - b. The coach shall be responsible for organizing practices and shall be the team representative to the USVBA
 - c. The assistant coach shall assist the coach, set up practice times, and coordinate schedule with Club Sport Director and Assistant in all matters relating to the club
 - d. The coach and assistant coach shall be elected at the end of the season for the upcoming academic year

ELIGIBILITY: The voting membership shall be limited to Vanderbilt students, faculty, and staff. A limited number of other persons may also be members of the club, but without voting privileges

FINANCES: Members shall be required to pay individual membership dues to the USVBA and contribute to the team Membership fee. Any revenue received by the club shall be used and deposited in a Club Sport and/or University account. All expenditures are to be monitored by the Club Sport Department

FACILITIES &
EQUIPMENT:

When available, practices should be conducted at

facilities on the Vanderbilt campus. Players will be required to furnish their own personal equipment.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to tournaments will be provided and paid for by the club members

MEDICAL

CONSIDERATIONS: Each player is responsible for his own medical care. Each player will be required to sign a release and assumption of risk form which will be kept on file in the Club Sport office

AWARDS: Single awards or trophies presented to the team shall be given to the University and displayed in the Club Sport trophy cabinet. Individual awards given to each player will remain the property of the player

PUBLICITY: The announcements and scheduling of tournaments will be published on the USVBA website. The student and local newspapers will also be invited to cover these events. Results of the team's tournament performances will also be given to USVBA.

MEETINGS: Members are expected to participate in scheduled practices. Any club business will be handled either before or after practice

CONDUCT: Conduct shall conform to University and USVBA policies
