

Constitution Vanderbilt Women's Volleyball Club

Purpose:

We are a group that loves volleyball and most have played in high school or club. We want to continue our love for volleyball through a competitive and enjoyable experience. We promote volleyball through travel and home tournaments to facilitate a competitive environment. We provide a higher competition, structure, and commitment than Intramurals.

Organization:

We will participate in the year Student Involvement Fair to recruit new members and provide team bond events to promote comradery and retention to the club. The club will be managed by a series of Executive Board Officers: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Publicity Chair, with an optional spot of Practice Coordinator. These positions will be elected at the end of the season for the upcoming academic year.

Commitment & Expectations:

All club members are encouraged to attend and be on time for all practice times and team bonding events. Tournament players are expected to attend and be on time for all practices unless there is prior communication to the President or a member(s) of the executive board with approval. Tournament players are expected to attend and be prompt to their respective tournaments; this includes being on time to pick up for away tournaments. Tournament players are also expected to be in a suitable state for tournaments, including but not limited to not being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, not being overly sleep-deprived to the point of the inability to stay awake, etc. All members are to notify the President or a member(s) of the executive board if there are conflicts with practices/tournaments/meetings with classes or exams as soon as it is known.

Eligibility:

Voting membership is limited to Vanderbilt students, faculty, and staff who have attended at least 7 practices a semester.

Finances:

Members are required to pay individual membership dues to Vanderbilt Women's Club Volleyball based on their level of participation. Practices players pay \$25 per semester, players who attended AT LEAST one tournament (travel or home) pay \$75 per semester, and those who attended Nationals will pay \$125 for the spring semester. Revenue received by the club through dues or merchandise sales is that of the club and is to be used strictly for club activities, travel, and equipment. Spending is determined by the elected executive board.

Facilities & Equipment:

Large equipment and courts are provided by the recreational center. Volleyballs and jerseys are the property of Women's Club Volleyball. Personal equipment including but not limited to court shoes, kneepads, spandex, etc. are expected to be acquired by the individual.

Transportation:

Transportation to away tournaments will be provided and paid for by the Women's Club Volleyball budget. Participants are expected to find transportation to practices and home tournaments on their own.

Medical Considerations:

Each player is responsible for her medical care. Each player will be required to sign a liability release and assumption of risk form which will be kept on file in the Club Sport Office.

Publicity & Communication:

Events will be posted on the Women's Club Volleyball page and the Women's Club Volleyball Instagram. Communication with members regarding tournaments, events, and general information will be done during practice, through GroupMe, and when necessary, by email.

Conduct:

Conduct shall conform to University, Recreational and Wellness Center, and NCVF policies.
